

Getting a Review

Reviewing the manuscripts of the articles is established by the editorial board of the scientific journal "Volga Region Pedagogical Search"

1. Organizing the review

1.1. All scientific articles submitted to the editorial board of the journal "Volga Region Pedagogical Search" are reviewed.

1.2. The Editor-In-Chief of the journal determines the correspondence of the article to the content of the journal, the structure, the scientific novelty and relevance. The Editor-In-Chief passes the manuscript to the specialist for being reviewed.

1.3. In order to review the manuscripts of the articles, the journal involves the members of the editorial board, highly qualified scientists and specialists of the Ulyanovsk State Pedagogical University and other state educational institutions of higher professional education (doctors of sciences, professors, candidates of sciences, associate professors) who have the scientific specialization closest to the topic of the article. The author or co-author of the peer-reviewed work cannot be its reviewer.

1.4. The timing of the review is the shortest possible.

1.5. The review is conducted confidentially. The information about the reviewer is anonymous to the authors and is intended only for inner usage. The reviewer does not know the name of the author/authors of the article.

1.6. The author of the article is given the opportunity to see the review. If necessary, the text of the review is sent to the author by e-mail or by post.

1.7. The presence of a positive review is not a sufficient basis for the publication of the article.

1.8. If the reviewer approves of the article as a whole, but if there are any comments, the text of the review with confidentiality is sent to the author. After the author submits the corrected article taking into account the comments of the reviewer, the article is sent for reconsideration to the same reviewer.

1.9. In case of receiving a negative review from the reviewer, the text of the review with confidentiality is sent to the author.

1.10. If there is a reasonable answer from the author to the comments of the reviewer, the article is to be sent for consideration by the commission, which is created as an exception and includes three representatives of the editorial board. Members of the commission do not know the name of the author/authors of the article.

1.11. The final decision on the appropriateness of the publication is taken by the editorial board of the journal and recorded during the meeting of the editorial board.

1.12. After the editorial board accepts the decision to admit the article to the publication, the Editor-In-Chief informs the author about it and specifies the terms of publication.

1.13. Original reviews are stored in the editorial board of the "Volga Region Pedagogical Search" for three years from the date of publication.

1.14. The publication is FREE.

2. The content of the review

2.1. The title of the review should indicate the title of the article, the time of receiving the article in the editorial office.

2.1. The review should contain a qualified analysis of the article's material, objective and reasoned evaluation of it and well-grounded recommendations.

2.2. The reviewer fills in the particular form

3. Editorial board of the scientific magazine

3.1. Reviewing of manuscripts is done by the members of the Editorial Board

3.2. List of experts is created by the Editor-In-Chief.
