

## **Publishing Ethics**

The editors are guided by the principles of scientific nature, objectivity, professionalism and impartiality. Their work is based on the Declaration of the Association of Science Editors and Publishers (ASEP) “Ethical Principles of Scientific Publications”, the recommendations of the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) and international standards of publication ethics.

The publisher, editors, authors and reviewers are responsible for observing ethical norms as to publication and spread of research results. The editor’s interaction with authors is based on the principles of justice, politeness, objectivity, honesty and transparency.

An author is a person who has made a substantial contribution to a concept development, collection of empirical material, procession and interpretation of the data obtained, or preparation of the text of a scholarly paper. All authors should take part in the preparation and critical discussion of the text of the manuscript submitted to the Journal.

A corresponding author is a person responsible for communication with the Editorial Board and the Editorial Council of the Journal in the process of submission, peer review and preparation for publication. The corresponding author is responsible for compliance with the Journal requirements related to text formatting and ethical norms, and should report about any conflict of interest that might arise.

All authors should disclose any financial or other substantive conflicts of interest that might be construed to affect the results or the conclusions of their manuscript. Financial support for any of the stages of research or the preparation of the manuscript (including grants and other financial support) should be disclosed in the main body of the article.

The Editorial Board considers sharing texts of the articles with other journals or other persons concerned without the express of written consent by the author to be copyright infringement and violation of the principle of confidentiality of editorial processes.

Any forms of plagiarism are unacceptable, including self-plagiarism. Simultaneous submission of one and the same manuscript to several publications is also improper. The Editorial Board tests the originality of submitted manuscripts by the “Antiplagiat” system (<https://www.antiplagiat.ru/>)
